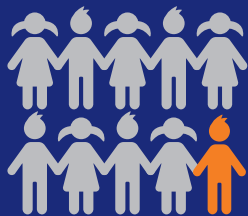
Brain tumors are the leading cause of cancer-related deaths in children.

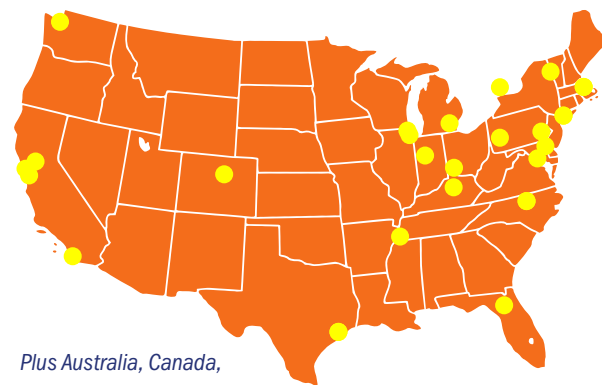
