ChadTough Defeat DIPG/DMG Foundation has awarded millions of dollars in grants to more than 30 institutions worldwide, funding promising pediatric brain cancer research with an emphasis on DIPG/DMG. We offer several types of grants to help us reach our goal: **finding a cure for DIPG/DMG.**

Review Process

Our Scientific Advisory Council consists of leading experts on childhood brain cancer. The Council reviews grant applications and makes recommendations based on the National Cancer Institute scoring system to ensure we use our resources to fund the most promising DIPG/DMG research projects.

OPTIONS (all grants span three years)

Fellowship Grant (up to \$300K)

Awarded to outstanding pre-doctoral and post-doctoral fellows under the guidance of a mentor to help develop the next generation of leaders in DIPG/DMG research.

New Investigator Grant (up to \$400K)

Supports newly independent DIPG/DMG researchers working to establish DIPG/DMG research labs – OR – established researchers (who have not previously conducted brain tumor research) to encourage them to start DIPG/DMG research.

Game Changer Grant (up to \$600K)

Funds hypothesis-driven research projects that represent an innovative approach to a major challenge in DIPG/DMG research, with a potential to lead to groundbreaking discoveries in the field.
